

The Art in Perpetuity Trust is running the third CREEKSIDE OPEN competition. **Jenni Lomax** will select the first show and **Mark Wallinger** will select the second show from the same open submission. Both exhibitions will be shown at the APT Gallery on Creekside, Deptford in May and June 2009.

Visual artists living or working in Greater London are invited to apply by submitting digital images of work that has been made since May 2007.

We welcome applications from all forms of media including video and audio submissions, however applied art is not eligible.

The APT Gallery on Creekside offers 158 square meters of high quality exhibition space and we hope that visitors to the two exhibitions will gain an insight into the scope of visual arts today.

The single submission from which two shows will be independently selected will offer artists two chances of showing at APT.

Eligibility

The CREEKSIDE OPEN 2009 is open to visual artists living or working in Greater London. Only one entry per person. The three submitted works must have been made since May 2007.

Media

Applications are welcomed from visual artists working in all media, except for applied art.

Entry Procedure

Artists must submit three different pieces of work as digital images. The Selectors will consider all three images and if successful, one of the three pieces will be included in the exhibition. The Selectors will view the submissions independently, so the three pieces will have two opportunities to be selected for the CREEKSIDE OPEN 2009.

We will accept:

JPEG : Resolution of 300pixels, width 1000 pixels or 8.5cm.

Video / audio : 3 minute excerpt on VHS / DVD / CD.

If the submission exceeds three minutes the submission will be disqualified.

Entry Fee

£18 for one entry of three pieces of work.

Return of Submission

All CDs and DVDs will be destroyed in August 2009. If you would like your submission to be returned please enclose a suitable stamped addressed envelope.
